

FRAME Innovation grants stage two application checklist.

(Applications not including the specified information will not be considered.)

Send queries and completed applications with supporting documents to amy@frame.org.uk. There is no set length for these full applications however they must include at minimum the information specified in this checklist, and the requested supporting documents.

Supporting Documents:

1. Names and contact information for lead applicant, main project researchers or supervisors.
2. A4 abridged CV of lead researcher (and other key researchers on project).
3. Evidence of contract at eligible organisation.
4. A referee supporting statement/letter for the lead applicant including referee contact details.

Please note: We will also require a signed copy of the FRAME Innovation Grant Terms & Conditions by the Host institution if a grant is offered.

Application:

4. A summary of the hypothesis, problem or idea including an evidence base, link to previous projects or current scientific knowledge.
5. Aims & objectives.
6. A lay summary of the project proposal and expected outcomes.
7. How the project fits with the purpose of the Innovation grants and FRAME judging criteria, including how the findings may impact the replacement of laboratory animals.
8. Proposed experimental plan, methods, and data analysis techniques.
9. Timeline or Gant chart.
10. How findings will be disseminated and proposed next steps (including further research).
11. Detailed budget breakdown (not to include salaries).
12. Risk assessment including ethical considerations/approvals.

13. List of collaborators and funding streams.
